A Session in Nursery - morning or afternoon

8:30-8:45	Door is open, children and families are welcomed into the nursery to access our play opportunities and over the year complete some starter session tasks.
8:45-9:00	Chn will go to their base carpet for registration, daily calendar chat and some topic provocations.
9:00-9:30	Chn will access continuous provision indoors/outdoors
9:30-9:45	Chn will return to their Carpet for their first group session. This could have a story, mark-making, maths or phonics focus.
9:45-10:35	Chn will access continuous provision indoors/outdoors
10:35-10:50	Chn will return to their Carpet for their second group session. This could have a story, mark-making, maths or phonics focus.
10:50-11:10	Chn will all go outside to access provision or play group games
11:10-11:25	Home time carpet including a story, songs and reflection time.
11:25-11:30	Home time
12:15-12:30	Door is open, children and families are welcomed into the nursery to access our play opportunities and over the year complete some starter session tasks.
12:30-12:45	Chn will go to their base carpet for registration, daily calendar chat and some topic provocations.
12:45-1:15	Chn will access continuous provision indoors/outdoors
1:15-1:30	Chn will return to their Carpet for their first group session. This could have a story, mark-making, maths or phonics focus.
1:30-2:20	Chn will access continuous provision indoors/outdoors
2:20-2:35	Chn will return to their Carpet for their second group session. This could have a story, mark-making, maths or phonics focus.
2:35-2:55	Chn will all go outside to access provision or play group games
2:55-3:10	Home time carpet including a story, songs and reflection time.
3:10-3:15	Home time
