Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our PE curriculum, it is important that your children are wearing the correct PE kit. This is to ensure they can do PE safely and effectively. A letter was sent out in July detailing what pupils must be wearing for PE at our school from this September.

Our school PE kit is as follows:



Your children must wear the above, **black and white** clothing for PE. The only other addition is a plain black or blue jumper for when the weather is cold.

A number of our children are still wearing the original, blue Chapel Street PE kit. This PE kit can still be used if you already have it. Any other forms or colours of clothing will not be allowed.

The above PE kit has been chosen because it is inexpensive, readily available from many stores and is something that most people already have.

On your child's PE days, children must attend school in their full PE kit. They must not come to school in school uniform. Initially, this was introduced to reduce the amount of items going to and from school to reduce the risk of spreading the Corona Virus but is being continued in order to maximise learning time for the children.
