For Reception to year 6...



Drop-off:

- Gates and classroom doors will open at **8:30am**
- Make sure you have dropped off before **8:40am**

Pick-up:

- Gates and classroom doors will open at **3:10pm**
- Make sure you have picked up before **3:20pm**

Breakfast club:

- Starts again from 7th September
- 7:45am to 8:30am every day
- £1 per child per session (£5 for the week)

What does my child need to bring to school?



All children in Nursery to Year 5 need a plain blue book bag. These can be bought from the office at school. They won't be allowed

other bags instead.

If your child has a packed lunch, they can bring this to school in a small lunch box.



Everything your child needs to learn, including pencils and other stationary, will be provided by school. Children must not bring pencil cases or other personal belongings, like toys or games, to school.

All clothing and items must be clearly labelled with your child's name.

School Uniform

To make our uniform more affordable, nothing needs to have the school logo on. It is important that your child wears the correct uniform to school every day.



white polo shirt



blue jumper



grey skirt



grey trousers



No jeans or denim

School shoes must be completely black.



No branding, colours or trainers.



Headscarves must be black or royal blue.

Simple, plain studs only for earrings.

Simple hairbands / bobbles in school colours only.



No nail varnish or makeup.

No jewellery.

No large or decorative hair bands or bobbles.



PE Kit

Children will continue to wear their PE kit to school on the days they have sport or PE. Your child's class teacher will let you know when this is. This means your child will not need a PE bag and will not keep PE kit in school. Children must all wear the correct PE kit when needed.



Children must wear a plain, white polo shirt or t-shirt with either plain black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms. Children must wear trainers with good rubber grips. A plain black/blue jumper can be worn in the winter months.



Children must not wear football kits, hoodies or branded coloured clothing. Pumps are not suitable for PE.

All clothing and items must be clearly labelled with your child's name.
