Stop the Spread of Flu...

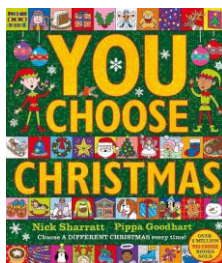
1. Get the flu vaccine
