Road Safety & Parking Outside School

At Chapel Street, we take road safety extremely seriously. We want to make sure our school, and the surrounding areas, are safe and accessible to all our families and our community.

Over the recent months, there has been an increase in speeding vehicles, illegal parking outside of school, dangerous maneuvers (turning in the road) and carelessness of drivers; especially at peak times at the start and end of the day.

As a school, we have shared our concerns and observations with Manchester City Council. The local authority is supporting us and helping to monitor the situation. Changes you may notice are:

- Members of the Senior Leadership Team will be at the gates wearing Hi-Vis jackets
- Parking Enforcement Officers will be present at various times throughout the day, across the week
- New signage introduced to remind and encourage drivers to take more care on the roads around school

So far, we have had a great response from many of our families; some of which have been extremely grateful and thankful for our actions and attempts at improving the road access and pedestrian access around school.

Rest assured, the improvements and measures we are putting in place are not to catch anyone out; more so in the hope that these measures will play a key role in ensuring safe, effective and consistent traffic management for our children and families in the future.
