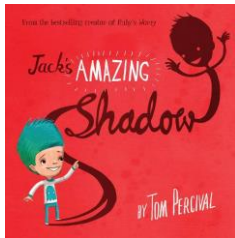

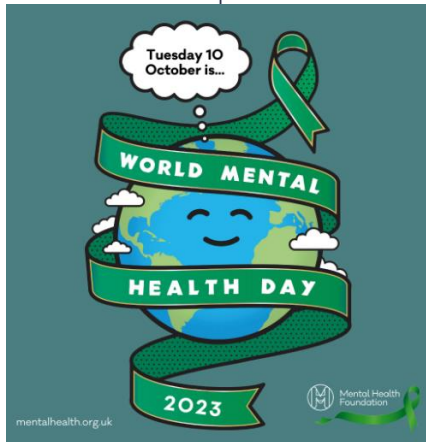
## #Take10toRead
