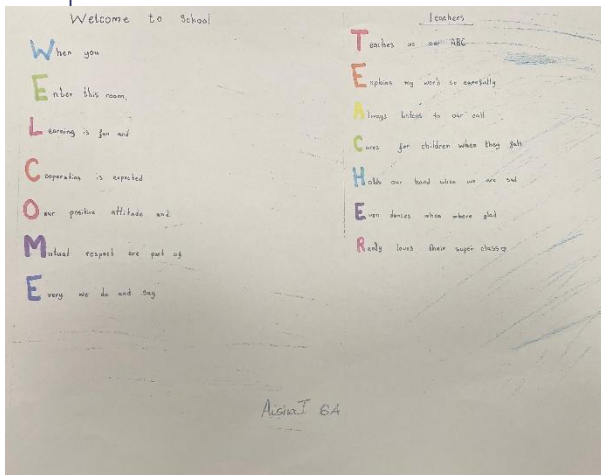
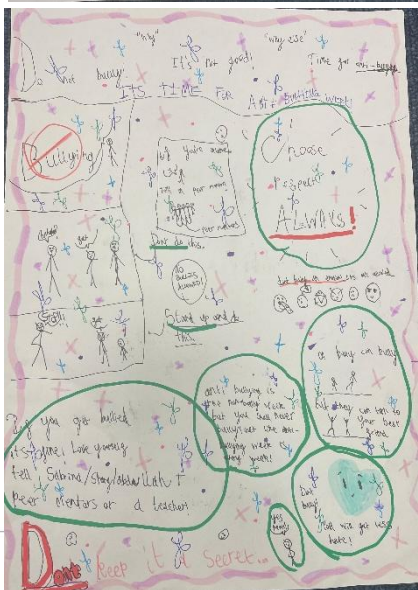
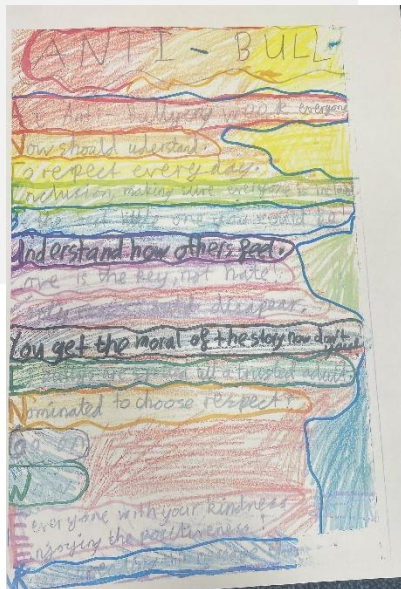
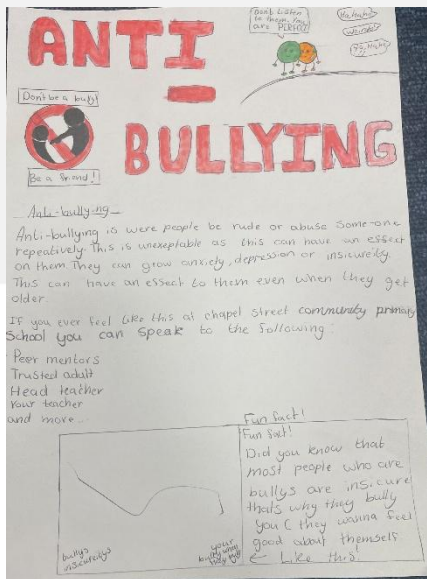


Anti-Bullying Week
