Attendance is one of our highest priorities at Chapel Street. Unfortunately, we are currently at 92.5%, which is well below the national average of 96%.

This greatly affects their academic performance and results. Did you know that 73 per cent of high school pupils who have over 95 % attendance achieve five or more GCSEs at grades A* to C?

You may not realise it but if your child has 90% attendance, it means that they have missed 9 days of school – that's 50 lessons!
